# **Frequently Asked Questions**

# 1. What is the program about?

The Community Planning/Labor Studies Changemakers Summer College Academy is a 4-week long college program where students will take several courses on leadership and community engagement.

#### 2. When and where are classes held?

All classes will be held at Los Angeles Trade Technical College (400 West Washington Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90015). Classes will be held from June 19<sup>th</sup> through July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and will run Monday through Thursday 9am-4:30pm and Fridays 9am-1:30pm

# 3. What is the cost of the program?

The Changemaker's Academy is a <u>free</u> college program for current and graduating high school students (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade); it is also free/low-cost to any other interested community members who apply for financial aid. Students will be provided lunch during the program.

# 4. What is the classes/subject matter taught?

- CP 17 Leadership Development Skills (3-units) M-TH, 9am-12:30pm
- LS 4 Labor in America (3-units), M-Th, 1pm-4:30pm
- Community Engagement Strategies (1-unit), Fridays, 9am-1pm

#### 5. What can I do with the credits earned through the program?

Students will earn up to 7 college-units in the program. All of the credits can be used towards a certificate or A.A. degree in the Community Planning & Economic Development Program or Labor Studies Program at LATTC. All credits are also CSU-transferrable. Graduates will also receive a Certificate of Completion at the culmination of the program
